DHBC Trustees at Work

The DHBC Trustees meet once a month to discuss issues pertaining to the church and its properties, including church-owned buildings and the grounds. They evaluate proposals that have financial implications about the use of the church and its grounds, including the parking lot, and they either approve or disapprove them. These are some of the recent changes at DHBC based on the work of the Trustees:

- The Trustees approved a proposal from AT&T to lease a small space for placement of a utility box on the northeast side of the church parking lot. The proceeds from this lease enabled the church to purchase a badly needed new refrigerator for the main church kitchen. The new energy-efficient utility refrigerator replaced an old appliance that was not working properly and was wasting energy.
- Intown Tumbling (www.intowntumbling.com) is leasing space for children's tumbling classes in a renovated area formerly used for Sunday school classes (Mrs. Brown's old classroom).
- HD1 (www.HD1restaurant.com), an upscale *Haute Doggery* featuring gourmet hot dogs, sausage, and other foods in a bun, is leasing parking spaces in the church lot nearest to the Social Hall. Although the spaces are labeled with HD1 on the pavement, church members and guests always have priority to park in them while at church functions.
- DHBC is leasing rooms to a few individuals for office and work space. In addition to the utilization of empty space and a modest rental fee, the church also gains because the tenants often pay for repairs and renovations to the spaces they are leasing.

The next Movie Night for our homeless neighbors will be Thursday, January 5th. Volunteers are needed at 6:15 for set up and after the movie for clean up.

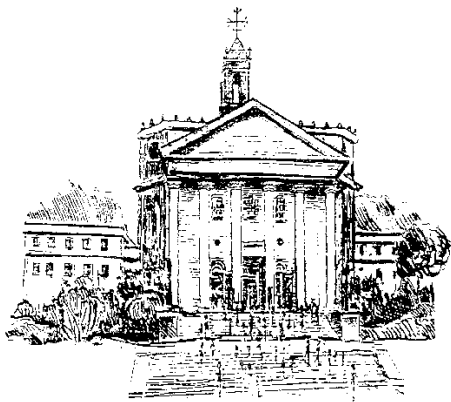
Next Men's Shelter Meal January 16th
